From Pastor Mike....

The old saying, "Time flies when you are having fun" is definitely true. I have been back as Pastor at AMC for a month, and I am having a blast and time is flying by. The Season of Lent and the celebration of Easter is just around the corner. Lent has always been a meaningful time in the Christian Church. This was the time used by the early church to prepare new believers for membership in the church. Early believers went through a time of catechism and study of the basic principles of Christianity during Lent and celebrated Easter Sunday as their first day of Church membership. I can only imagine how special that first time of worship and communion was for the early Christians.

Lent is also a time for us as modern-day believers to look afresh and anew at the foundations of our faith and beliefs. To help us accomplish this task, we have planned several special projects.

- On February 14, we gather as a church to celebrate "Ash Wednesday" in the church sanctuary starting at 6:30 PM. We will share in a time of reflection and worship prior to the Imposition of Ashes. All are invited to come and worship with us on that evening.
- Starting on Thursday morning, February 22, I will be leading a Bible Study on the "Letters to the Thessalonians." This eight-week study will meet on Thursday mornings beginning at 10:30 AM and continue until 12:00 PM. Individual study guides will be available for this study.
- During the Sundays of Lent, I will be preaching a New Series entitled "The Demands of Membership." I will be highlighting the vows of membership that one takes when joining the church – promises to be faithful in our Prayers, Presence, Gifts, Services, and Witness.
- "Palm Sunday" will be celebrated on March 24 at 10:45 AM in the church sanctuary. Come out and not only raise your voice in praise but also raise a palm branch in joy.
- The church will gather on "Maundy Thursday", March 28 at 6:30 PM for Holy Communion and reflection. This is aways a poignant time of worship.
- Easter Sunday worship, March 31 will be a great time of celebration and worship as we highlight the resurrection of Jesus the Christ. What could be more thrilling than to join together as a church family on this wondrous occasion.

I hope you will mark these dates on your calendars and participate in as many as possible. These are opportunities for our church to come together as a family and celebrate the gift of salvation and life given to us by Jesus the Christ. Plus, these special worship times are a wonderful opportunity to invite friends and family to worship with us.
