From Pastor Mike....

One of the distinctive and essential characteristics of Methodist theology and thought is the belief in "Personal Holiness." In a recent Bible Study on the letters of Paul to the church at Thessalonica, we found what I believe is a wonderful description of "Personal Holiness" that makes this concept easier to understand. In 1 Thessalonians 2:12, Paul urges believers to **"walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory."**

This verse intrigues me on several levels. One is that Paul teaches us that this "walking worthy" does not come from our own personal power or decision but rather comes about as a result of God's grace in our lives. This grace transforms us and empowers us to become all that God designed us to be from the beginning. But how do we make this transformation happen if not from our own doing? Paul proclaims that when one encounters God's word – through listening to preaching, in Bible study, meditation on God's word, song, prayer, and other expressions – the power of God goes to work in us, and transformation happens. In other words, we do not do these "religious" things to prove our holiness but rather when we allow God's word to take up residence in our hearts and spirits, holiness happens in us by the very presence of God's Holy Spirit in our lives. Our task becomes one of simply spending time with God.

The second concept that strikes me in this passage is that "God calls believers". So many times, we think that the gift of salvation is given to save us from Hell and secure a place in Heaven, which it does. But this scripture tells us that in addition to this gift God, through His grace, calls us to become involved in ministry and service to others – both fellow believers and those outside the kingdom of God. Believers have a divine responsibility of sharing God's grace with others and finding ways to become the "hands and feet of Christ" in their lives.

This is how "Personal Holiness" becomes real and authentic in our lives. It is not the individual doing something for others but rather God transforming us into the likeness of Jesus Christ and then living out of that new creation. It is not a behavior, or a way of doing better, but is an expression of God's presence, grace, and love growing in our lives and manifested toward others. "Personal Holiness" becomes the natural, normal expression of who we are and who God is desires for us to be and become. To live in this manner is to truly walk in a manner worthy before God. May this be our prayer as God's individual disciples and as His church.
