It would seem that hundreds of dollars are spent purchasing the appropriate gift to convince one's "special" friend that they are indeed the "love of one's life". It would also so seem that to fail to purchase kitschy gifts of red and white and chocolate covered treats can also get one in deep trouble with that certain special someone. 
